

In the early hours of the morning of 25 April 1915, troops from the Australian and New Zealand Army Corps (ANZAC) landed on the beaches of the Gallipoli Peninsula in Türkiye (formerly known as Turkey). The ANZAC troops were part of a large Allied campaign designed to bring World War 1 to an end. Each year on 25 April, commemorative services are held at dawn around the world to recognise the sacrifices made by so many at Gallipoli. ANZAC Day, as it is now known, provides an opportunity to also remember all who have suffered through conflict and war.

The Australian and New Zealand communities in Singapore will once again hold the ANZAC Day Commemorative Dawn Service at Kranji War Memorial Cemetery.

2025 represents the 110th anniversary of ANZAC Day and we welcome your attendance to help recognise the sacrifices of the service men and women who have gone before us.
